Pursuant to 21 NCAC 22F .0113(a), a Registered Apprentice shall submit a report of the apprenticeship experience no later than ten working days after the date that any of the following conditions exist:

- 1. The apprentice and sponsor are separated for any reason and thus invalidating the apprentice registration certificate;
- 2. The apprentice who is not an Audiologist, as defined in 21 NCAC 22A. 0301 (s) [i.e., does not hold a valid permanent NC Audiologist License], has held a valid apprentice registration certificate for 365 calendar days;
- 3. The apprentice, who holds a masters degree in Audiology and is not an Audiologist, has completed 250 clock hours of supervision prior to first taking the qualifying examination;

4. The apprentice has been notified by the Board that the apprentice failed the qualifying examination, and the individual is reapplying for issuance of a license by examination; or
5. The Board has issued a written request to the registered apprentice for submission of a report, in order to determine fulfillment of the apprentice experience requirements.
